Cash fare accepted. Paid directly to the fare box while boarding the bus. Exact fare required. Drivers do not carry change.

Adults and children five years old and older = \$1.00

Children under five years old = Free

Youth fare (five to 15 years old); Daily 6:00pm to midnight and all day Saturday = **\$0.75**

CAMBUS:

University of lowa's public transit that provides fixed-route service throughout the campus.

No fare and open to the general public.

For qualifying persons with disabilities CAMBUS also provides ADA paratransit service for University of Iowa Affiliates called <u>Bionic Bus</u>: (319)335-7595.

Johnson County SEATS

<u>SEATS</u> is open to the general public and provides paratransit and rural service. To learn more about SEATS or submit a comment or complaint call (319)339-6128.

Paratransit: ADA Paratransit Service is for individuals with disabilities that cannot board, ride, or get to an accessible Coralville or Iowa City fixed route bus due to their disability. Rides with SEATS are scheduled 1 day to 2 weeks in advance by calling the scheduling line (319)339-6125; the scheduling line is answered 7AM-12PM and 1-4PM Monday-Friday and Saturday from 8AM-12PM. For same day rides (not guaranteed) call (319)339-6127. All riders must apply and be certified by the city in which they reside. Each city has their own set of requirements and determines their own hours of operation:

Coralville: (319)248-1790; Iowa City: (319)356-5158; North Liberty: (319)248-1790; University Heights: (319)337-6900.

Rural Service: SEATS Service is available to the general public in rural areas. No application is required, eligibility is determined when address is shared. Call (319)339-6125 to schedule. At least 24 hours and no more than two weeks in advance. The more advance notice the better. Rural trips are approved based on vehicle and driver availability. Rural trips are scheduled as follows:

- Northeast: Solon, Shueyville, Swisher, Morse, Oasis and surrounding areas —Monday, Tuesday, Thursday 8:30AM to 4:30PM
- South: Lone Tree, Sharon Center, Hills, Fry Town and surrounding areas Monday, Wednesday, Friday 8:30AM to 4:30PM
- West: Oxford, Tiffin, Cosgrove and surrounding areas Tuesday, Thursday 8:30AM to 4:30PM

SEATS One-way fare = \$2.00 (for both paratransit or rural trips)

Paid in exact cash or with a punch card available for purchase at the SEATS office; punch cards are \$20 and have 10-rides per card

Transfers:

- Both Coralville Transit and Iowa City Transit offer transfers when it takes a rider more than one route to reach their one-way destination.
- Transfers are honored between each system for the purpose of completing a one-way trip. I.E.: if you live in Coralville and need to get to lowa City a transfer is allowed.
- Transfers are free and should be requested when fare is paid.
- Transfers are not issued to rider's with 24 hour passes or if the starting point is the downtown interchange. Transfers are not needed for 31-day passes.
