Corridor Rides

Online rideshare platform. Search for single ride matching, vanpool or carpool. Create a profile online to connect with other commuters and start a carpool. Vanpools are for 5-15 people who live and work in the same area. A primary driver is designated to drive the vehicle. Vanpool is administered by Enterprise Rideshare who provides gas, insurance and vehicle maintenance. Corridor Rides offers a \$400 a month subsidy for groups commuters living in the Corridor. Monthly pricing varies based on vehicle type and number of vanpool members. Accessible vehicles available.

Johnson County SEATS

Open to the general public and provides paratransit and rural service. To learn more about SEATS or submit a comment or complaint call **(319)339-6128**. Service details:

Paratransit: ADA Paratransit Service is for individuals with disabilities that cannot board, ride, or get to an accessible Coralville or Iowa City fixed route bus due to their disability. Rides with SEATS are scheduled 1 day to 2 weeks in advance by calling the scheduling line **(319)339-6125**; the scheduling line is answered 7AM-12PM and 1-4PM Monday-Friday and Saturday from 8AM-12PM. For same day rides (not guaranteed) call **(319)339-6127**. All riders must apply and be certified by the city in which they reside. Each city has their own set of requirements and determines their own hours of operation:

Coralville: (319)248-1790; Iowa City: (319)356-5158; North Liberty: (319)248-1790; University Heights: (319)337-6900

Rural Service: SEATS service is available to the general public in rural areas. No application is required, eligibility is determined when address is shared. Call **(319)339-6125** to schedule. At least 24 hours and no more than two weeks in advance. The more advance notice the better. Rural trips are approved based on vehicle and driver availability. Rural trips are scheduled as follows:

Northeast: Solon, Shueyville, Swisher, Morse Oasis and surrounding areas — Monday, Tuesday, Thursday 8:30AM to 4:30PM

South: Lone Tree, Sharon Center, Hills, Fry Town and surrounding areas — Monday, Wednesday, Friday 8:30AM to 4:30PM



West: Oxford, Tiffin, Cosgrove and surrounding areas — Tuesday, Thursday 8:30AM to 4:30PM

Also For individuals in the first 2 weeks of new employment the Crisis Center can provide 10 –ride/20-ride bus passes for Coralville Transit and/or Iowa City Transit. Employer must verify new employment.

Iowa City Public Library

Ride and Read (year-round program): library cardholders may present their card to any public service desk at the Library and receive a free bus pass to use on an Iowa City Transit bus that day. There's a limit of two passes per week. Summer Library Bus program: Kids through 12th grade, and the adult caregivers with them, can ride any Iowa City Transit bus for free between 9 am and 3 pm weekdays during Iowa City Schools' summer vacation. Cardholders just show their Library Card when getting on the bus.
