### AGREEMENT FOR BUILDING INSPECTOR SERVICES

WHEREAS, this agreement is entered into by the City of Shueyville, Iowa, municipal corporation, and Johnson County, Iowa, municipal corporation, pursuant to Chapter 28E of the Code of Iowa; and

WHEREAS, the City of Shueyville, Iowa desires to obtain the services of a Building Official or Building Inspector for purposes of conducting inspections pursuant to the City of Shueyville Building Code; and

WHEREAS, Johnson County, Iowa has personnel experienced and involved in the enforcement of the Johnson County Building Code; and

WHEREAS, the City of Shueyville has adopted the Shueyville Building code which is identical to the Johnson County Building Code; and

WHEREAS, Johnson County Iowa is willing to make said personnel available to the City of Shueyville, Iowa, for purposes of inspections pursuant to the Shueyville Building Code and to act on behalf of said City as a City Building Official.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

- That Johnson County shall provide the services of Building Official for the City of Shueyville, Iowa. The Building Official shall provide all building inspection services from review of a building permit application through issuance of a building permit. Specifically, services shall include inspections and related administration, including cooperation with the City of Shueyville's enforcement measures and with appeals to the City of Shueyville Board of Appeals, all pursuant to the provision s of the Building Code as adopted by the City of Shueyville. These services shall not include enforcement, which shall be provided by the City of Shueyville.
- 2. The services described above shall commence effective immediately upon The execution of this instrument and its being filed with the Iowa Secretary of State and recorded with the Johnson County Recorder's Office, pursuant to Section 28E.8 of the Code of Iowa.
- 3. That as compensation for the services of said Johnson County Building Official, Johnson County shall receive all fees collected for the issuance of building, mechanical, plumbing and electrical permits and licenses issued by said Johnson County Building Official while acting in the capacity of City Building Official for the City of Shueyville. Fees shall be in accordance with those established by the City of Shueyville in the Shueyville Building Code.

- That said Johnson County Building Official shall serve as the contact 4. person for the Mayor of the City of Shueyville (or designee) with regard to any matters related to this agreement.
- That either party shall have the right to terminate this agreement by 5. delivery of a written notice of such intent to the Mayor of the City of Shueyville or the Chairperson of the Johnson County Board of Supervisors. Thirty (30) days after the delivery of such written notice of intent to terminate this Agreement, all provisions herein shall become null and void and of no effect.
- That the building inspector shall provide service to applicants in the City 6. of Shueyville within the same parameters established by Johnson County for its applicants, including, but not limited to, inspections within 24 hours of a properly submitted request for inspection.
- All applicants shall begin the permit process by obtaining the necessary 7. forms from the Shueyville City Clerk. The City shall issue all building permits upon receipt of certification from the Johnson County Building Inspector that all requirements have been met.

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE AS AMENDED BY JOHNSON COUNTY FOR CONSTRUCTION IN THE CITY OF SHUEYVILLE, IOWA AND DELETING JOHNSON COUNTY ORDINANCE 01.04.01.Z1, SECTION IV.AA.106.2(1) AND SUBSTITUTING THERETO SECTION 3.

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SHUEYVILLE, IOWA:

- Section 1. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this ordinance is to adopt the Uniform Building Code as amended by Johnson County for all construction in the City.
- Section 2. <u>Uniform Building Code Adoption as Amended by Johnson County</u>. The City hereby adopts the Uniform Building Code, as adopted and amended by Johnson County Ordinance Nos. 07.20.00.Z1 and 01.04.01.Z1.
- Section 3. <u>Deletion of certain sections of Johnson County Ordinance</u>. Section IV.A 106.2 of Johnson County Ordinance 01.04.01.Z1 is hereby deleted and the following is inserted in lieu thereof:
- 106.2 Work Exempted from Inspection or Compliance to Existing Building Standards. An inspection and/or compliance to existing building standards shall not be required for the following:

One-detached accessory building used as tool and storage sheds, playhouses and similar uses, decks, additions or garages, provided the floor area does not exceed one hundred forty-four (144) square feet and the lot placed thereon is a two family or less dwelling lot.

- Section 4. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
- Section 5. <u>Severability</u>. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged to be invalid or constitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 6. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval, and posting as provided by law.

# AMENDING THE SHUEYVILLE BUILDING PERMIT TO INCLUDE INSTALLATION OF E911 SIGN REQUIREMENT

WHEREAS, every owner of real property containing a primary structure has been assigned an E911 address: and

WHEREAS, City of Shueyville Code of Ordinances Title IV, Chapter 5, Section 4-5-3 states that the placing of numbers, including 911 numbering is mandatory; and

WHEREAS, each property owner has received an E911 sign either from the County or City of Shueyville; and

WHEREAS, there may be a need for emergency services such as fire, ambulance and law enforcement to locate within the City of Shueyville;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City Shueyville, Iowa does hereby resolves as follows:

- 1. The requirement of the installation of an E911 sign will be part of the City of Shueyville building permit process.
- 2. A Certificate of Occupancy will not be issued until such E911 sign is installed.
- 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
