- ***Jail Bed Dates***

Number of jail bed days one year PRIOR to Jail Alternatives: 76,153

Number of jail bed days one year POST Jail Alternatives: 36,806

**Potential jail bed days saved: 39,347**

The most recent cost of a jail bed day for Johnson County is estimated to be \$71 per day.
