NEW CONSTRUCTION PERMIT: An application to construct a new private sewage disposal system must be submitted to Johnson County Public Health and approved prior to construction of the system.	\$300.00
ALTERATION PERMIT: An alteration permit is required prior to conducting any change that affects the treatment or disposal of the waste, including replacement of the primary or secondary components, or a change in the design of a private sewage disposal system from the design that was originally installed and approved by the administrative authority.	\$175.00
PERMIT EXTENSION : A permit to construct or alter a private sewage disposal system shall expire one year from the issue date. An extension may be granted for no more than one year past the original permit expiration date.	\$50.00
COMMERICIAL/INDUSTRIAL USE PERMIT: A use permit is a renewable and revocable permit to	\$25.00
operate and maintain a private sewage disposal system that serves a property or properties zoned for commercial or industrial use.	ANNUAL FEE DUE UPON RENEWAL APRIL 1ST
OPERATION PERMIT: An operation permit is a renewable and revocable permit to operate and maintain a private sewage disposal system that incorporates the discharge of treated effluent in its design.	
Note: The State of Iowa requires that all discharges from private sewage disposal systems which are discharged into, or have the potential to reach, any designated waters of the state or subsurface drainage tile shall be treated in a manner that will conform with the requirements of NPDES General Permit No. 4 issued by the department of natural resources, as reference in 567—Chapter 64. Prior to the use of any system discharging to designated waters of the state or a subsurface drainage tile, a Notice of Intent to be covered by the NPDES General Permit No. 4 shall be submitted to the department. Systems covered by this permit must meet all applicable requirements listed in the permit, including effluent sampling and monitoring.	\$35.00 ANNUAL FEE DUE UPON RENEWAL APRIL 1ST
PENALTY FEE FOR INSTALLATION WITHOUT A PERMIT: It is the responsibility of the person who constructs or alters a private sewage disposal system to ensure that a permit has been issued prior to commencement of work.
