RESOLUTION DESIGNATING JOHNSON COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH AS AGENCY TO COORDINATE THE DELIVERY OF PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES IN JOHNSON COUNTY, IOWA

Whereas, Iowa Code Chapter 137 and 641 Iowa Administrative Code Chapter 77, define the structure, powers, and duties of local boards of health; and

Whereas, Iowa Code Section 137.104(c) specifically empowers local boards of health to employ persons as necessary for the efficient discharge of its duties; and

Whereas, the Iowa Public Health Standards, as currently adopted by the State Board of Health, include a standard that local boards of health designate a local public health agency to coordinate the delivery of public health services on its behalf; and

Whereas, said Standards further require such designation be specifically adopted even if that agency is directly governed by the local board of health, and that it include the term of the designation, scope of the designation, and any compensation to be provided to the designated agency.

Now therefore, be it resolved by the Johnson County Board of Health, that Johnson County Public Health, a local agency directly governed by the Board of Health, is hereby designated as the local public health agency authorized to coordinate the delivery of public health services in Johnson County; and

Be it further resolved that, this designation shall extend to the delivery of all applicable public health services in Johnson County and remain in effect unless and until the Johnson County Board of Health designates another agency in its place. Compensation for the agency shall be as outlined in the Johnson County Board of Health's annual budget as approved by the Johnson County Board of Supervisors.
