
Transportation Options for Seniors in Johnson County

Seniors 65 and older can ride free anytime on Coralville Transit by showing a Senior Pass or Medicare Card. Coralville resident can obtain a Senior Pass by providing a photo ID and proof of residency at Coralville City Hall. Iowa City and Univ. Heights residents can obtain a Senior Pass to ride Coralville Transit by providing a photo ID and proof of residency at the Iowa City Parking and Transit office at 335 E Iowa Ave. North Liberty residents can obtain a Senior Pass to ride Coralville Transit by providing a photo ID and proof of residency at North Liberty City Hall.	319-248-1790 www.coralville.org/ transit
