## Accessing MHDS Services and Information





## Non-Medicaid (Regional) Funded Services

Access and/or information to the Johnson County MHDS service system for non-Medicaid funded services can be achieved by contacting the local Johnson County office at 855 S. Dubuque Street, Iowa City, IA 52240 319-339-6169 and connecting with one of the regional social workers. Residents can be assisted in completing applications and receiving resource and referral information by phone, email, or in-person. Johnson County MHDS is a member of a nine-county disability service system that is responsible to provide comprehensive mental health (AKA brain health) and disability services to individuals in these nine eastern Iowa counties. Due to this partnership, known as MHDS of the East Central Region (ECR), the regional application is used to request regionally-funded (ECR) assistance. ## **Medicaid Funded Services (HCBS Waiver Services)**

Access to Medicaid-funded services starts by completing an Iowa Dept. of Health and Human Services (FKA DHS) Medicaid/Waiver application through their online portal <a href="https://dhsservices.iowa.gov/apspssp/ssp.portal">https://dhsservices.iowa.gov/apspssp/ssp.portal</a> or

downloading the paper application at <a href="https://hhs.iowa.gov/how-to-apply">https://hhs.iowa.gov/how-to-apply</a>. The applicant must be accessing services from one of the seven HCBS Waivers to receive case management services. Johnson County Case Management serves people receiving either the Brain Injury Waiver or Intellectual Disability Waiver that have Fee-for-Service enrollment through the HIPP (Health Insurance Premium Payment program) rather than Managed Care enrollment.
