We need your help for the following volunteer positions and events!

Snowshoe Groomers

Help us to groom various trails at Kent Park by hiking in snowshoes to pack down the snow. Trails needing groomed are the CEC 1/2 mile loop, the trail down to the Fishing Pond from the CEC, and the trail around Kent Park Lake. You can check out JCC snowshoes to wear during a two-hour time slot or bring your own if available. These slots are only available on various weekday work hours. Those with access to personal snowshoes have no time/ day limitations. Winter Trail Maintenance at Cangleska Wakan

Two volunteer trail stewards are needed to help manage the trail system at Cangleska Wakan. In this role, the trail steward would commit to hiking a two-mile portion of the four-mile trail network every month until spring. While hiking, volunteer would use hand clippers to trim vegetation that is reaching into the trail corridor, namely viney wild rose stems. They would also move snow-bent shrubs, fallen sticks, and any limbs manageable. Volunteers should already know the trail system at Cangleska Wakan, be physically capable of hike in forest terrain that is steeply slopes in places. Access to snowshoes a plus for easier travel on trails during heavy snow.

Woodworking for Reptiles

We're seeking a volunteer with basic woodworking skills and access to their own woodworking tools to create a snake engagement board to enhance our three education snakes' mental and physical health. JCC would provide materials, you provide the time and skill.
