

DISCOUNT PROGRAMS FOR PUBLIC TRANSIT SYSTEMS IN JOHNSON COUNTY



Free Transit ANYTIME on Coralville and Iowa City buses for cardholders of:

65 + Senior Pass

- Coralville or North Liberty residents: Take proof of age (ID) and residency to Coralville City Hall if Coralville resident, North Liberty City Hall if North Liberty resident to be issued a Senior Pass to present at boarding for free rides on Coralville or Iowa City buses.
- Iowa City or University Heights residents: Present proof of age (ID) to driver at boarding for free ride. Or bring proof of age (ID) and residency to 335 E Iowa Ave to be issued an Senior Pass to present at boarding for free rides on Iowa City or Coralville buses.

Disabled Pass

- Present Disabled pass at boarding for free rides on Iowa City or Coralville buses.
- To Apply: Complete the top portion of the Disabled Bus Pass form. Use Coralville Transit form if you live in Coralville or North Liberty. Use Iowa City Transit form if you live in Iowa City or University Heights. Next, have a physician complete and sign the bottom portion of the form. To receive your pass, bring your completed form to Coralville City Hall (if Coralville resident) or North Liberty City Hall (if North Liberty resident) or Parking and Transit office 335 E Iowa Ave (if Iowa City or University Heights resident).

Medicare Card

- Present Medicare card at boarding for free rides

ADA Paratransit Rider

- Present certification card at boarding for free rides

► CommUnity

Bus Passes: Provides single ride bus tickets for Iowa City Transit: available on the 1st day of the month until gone, limited to 3 per household per month. For individuals in the first 2 weeks of new employment CommUnity can provide bus passes for Coralville Transit and/or Iowa City Transit. Employer must verify new employment.

Gas Vouchers: CommUnity offers gas vouchers by in-person appointment. Vouchers are for \$30 at Waterfront Hyvee.

► Johnson County General Assistance

► Iowa City Public Library

Ride and Read (year-round program): library cardholders may present their card (including their student AIM card) to any public service desk at the Library and receive a free bus pass to use on an Iowa City Transit bus that day. There's a limit of two passes per week.

Summer Library Bus: Kids through 12th grade, and the adult caregivers with them, can ride any Iowa City Transit bus for free when traveling to the Library during Iowa City Schools' summer vacation, weekdays between 9 am and 3 pm – just show your library card to the bus driver.
